**HIRING OF FULLY COVERED LORRIES FOR THE DELIVERY OF EXPLOSIVES  
YEAR 2022/2023**

1. CEFAP Unit of Sri Lanka Navy is inviting bids from prospective service providers for Hiring of fully covered 09 Ton Lorries to CEFAP Unit for the period of 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2022 to 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2023. Please quote charges for 09 Ton Lorries per trip as indicated below;

Transport charge from Naval Base Welisara to Explosive Factory, Mahawatta, Henegama, Mirigama and back to Naval Base Welisara, with load. (Approx. distance 120 Kms)				

Note: - All taxes should be specified and to be included in the bid.

2. In addition, following conditions to be adhered.


**CONDITIONS**

- a. Vehicle load space should be, interior with timber deck and sides, in good running condition, lockable and comprehensively insured.

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- b. The drivers should possess valid certificates of competency for driving and an assistant should be provided for each vehicle. Copies of their National Identity Cards to be provided in advance.
- c. The fuel / lubricant and other costs to be borne by the contractors / owners.
- d. The contractor should be able to provide the services at short notice.
- e. In the event of breakdown or accident during the journey, the contractor to ensure the safety of cargo and same to be dispatched to destination by a substitute vehicle within 06 hours of incident.
- f. Preference will be given to bidder with their own pool vehicle. The owners / Contractors are required to indicate details of Lorries available.
- g. The Department Procurement Committee reserves to itself the right without question of rejecting any or all tenders and the right of accepting any portion of a quotation. Bidders should be prepared to accept and execute a portion of the tender at the rate quoted by them.
- h. Service provider should be able to provide up to maximum of 05 No's Covered Lorries at any given time.
- j. Successful Tenderer should enter into an agreement with the Commander of the Navy prior to the execution of the order.
- k. This tender should be sent in duplicate in favour of the Captain Logistics Department (West) SLNS 'Mahasen', Welisara, Ragama in a sealed and registered cover or inserted in the tender box kept in the office of Captain Logistics Department (West) at above address.
- m. The envelope containing the tender should be marked TENDER FOR THE HIRING OF COVERED LORRIES QUOTATION OPENNING DATE 28<sup>th</sup> July 2022 on the top of left-hand corner and should reach no later than 1400 hrs on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2022.
- n. Tenderers should be prepared to make available a sample Lorry for inspection if required by the Sri Lanka Navy, when informed to do so prior award of tender.
- p. Need to enter in to a contract agreement within 07 days after the award of tender and need to provide Rs 100,000.00 performance bond for the period of contract.
- q. The service provider shall not change the quoted rate of hiring after opening the tender due to any reason.
