## Evaluation and Qualification Criteria

(viii) If the composition of the explosive deviates from the manufacturer's specifications while stored under the manufacturer recommended, temperature-controlled storage conditions and within the specified Shelf Life the supplier shall replace or deliver the deteriorated quantity at no additional cost.
